

TOWN MANAGER'S REPORT

If you are a regular reader of this newsletter or an attendee at our monthly CCA Board meetings, you'll know that for quite some time the Board and Town Hall staff have been working towards improving our playground facilities at both Swann and Willows Parks. Going back to 2019 when the Parks Rejuvenation Committee conducted a survey that showed replacing the aging equipment was a priority for residents, we have been seeking ways to make that happen. Since then, we have been putting certain funds aside each year but know that without additional outside resources it would be many years before we could afford to complete this project on our own. So, we reached out for help from the State of Maryland in 2021 but came up short. We tried again in 2022 and this time it worked!

I am thrilled to report that the State, via a Legislative Bond Initiative (LBI) sponsored by our District 33 legislators (with help from District 21, too), has fully funded our request to help rebuild the playgrounds! It was a team effort by our legislators, but I want to especially thank Senator Dawn Gile (D-33) for making this her top priority on the Senate side and ushering it through the highly competitive LBI process. These funds, along with what we have already saved, plus additional grant money still in the works, will enable us to fully realize the vision for our parks and improve not only the play experience, but the accessibility to these spaces. Thanks to ALL who had a hand in making this dream a reality!

POLICE CHIEF'S REPORT

Starting a Neighborhood Watch in Your Neighborhood

– There has been some interest in starting or restarting Neighborhood Watch programs around Crofton. National Neighborhood Watch is a national program organized by the National Sheriffs' Association, and the Crofton Police Department is a registered agent for the program, however, there are currently no active registered neighborhoods in Crofton.

The program requires the establishment of block Captains and a neighborhood committee, as well as establishing communications with the Crofton Police Department and establishing a neighborhood communication plan.

CCA board member Brian Riley is organizing a test case in the Willows neighborhood for launching the program in Crofton. The CCA will provide signage, decals, and program books to neighborhoods in the Crofton SCBD that meet criteria to be set through this test case. If you are interested in possibly taking the lead in your neighborhood, please write to CCA Comptroller Jim Harvey at Comptroller@croftontownhall.org with your contact information and the neighborhood you wish to represent. We will make a list of prospective neighborhoods from this information and will reach out to those who express an interest with more information once the test case is completed and up and running.

MOSQUITO CONTROL FOR 2023-24

This notice is to inform residents of the Crofton Special Community Benefit District of mosquito control services that are being provided by the Maryland Department of Agriculture, in cooperation with the Anne Arundel County Government, for the 2023 – 2024 period. Between April and October, a County-wide surveillance and control of larval mosquitoes will be conducted. Surveillance and control of adult mosquitoes will be conducted between May 31 and October 3.

Spraying for adult mosquitoes will be done only if an MDA employee determines it is necessary. The frequency of ULV spray treatments will be based on the level of mosquito infestation and the resources available. Spraying will not be conducted if it is raining, the winds exceed 12 MPH or the temperature exceeds 89 degrees. Please note that ULV spray treatment of adult tiger mosquitoes is most effective when conducted in

conjunction with community clean up efforts to remove standing water containers. Birdbaths and containers under potted plants should be flushed twice a week. Old tires should be properly disposed of and not stored in yards. Roof gutters and down spouts should be kept clean. Dripping outdoor faucets should be repaired. Collections of water in tarps or grill covers should be drained. If stored outside or under decks, items like pails, wading pools, wheelbarrows and such should be turned upside down.

Residents who would like their property to be exempt from adult mosquito control service must notify the MDA in writing, using the Department of Agriculture’s request form. The Request Form is available from the MDA’s website at <https://bit.ly/3MhZWdP>. Hardcopies are available at Crofton Town Hall for Special Community Benefit District residents.

Mark your calendar and plan on coming out to honor those who serve. Bring some chairs, the family, and even the family dog!




Crofton Social Media Network
