1.2.1 CROFTON POLICE DEPARTMENT JURISDICTION

The Crofton Police Department exercises full law enforcement jurisdiction within the geographic confines of the Crofton Special Community Benefit District (The Triangle). The triangle consists of the area within Route 450, Route 424, and Route 3. The following communities **are not** part of the Crofton Police jurisdiction:

Cedar Grove
 Courts of Crofton
 Crofton Commons
 Chaney's Grant
 Crofton Manor

The following streets within the triangle are not part of the Crofton Police Jurisdiction:

1.2.2 CONCURRENT JURISDICTION

Through a memorandum of understanding dated 06/08/2017 between the Crofton Police Department and the Anne Arundel County Police Department have concurrent jurisdiction within the Crofton Special Community Benefit District (The Triangle). For purposes of routine patrol the Crofton Police Department has primary responsibility and the Anne Arundel County Police Department may assist as requested or as required by an AACoPD supervisor.

1.2.3 OUT OF JURISDICTION ASSISTANCE

Crofton Police Department Officers have statewide jurisdiction pursuant to the Maryland Code, Criminal Law, 5-802. Crofton Police Department may, at time, be called upon by the AACoPD to assist their officer within the boundaries of Anne Arundel County on Priority 1 calls as defined by AACoPD policy and any other in progress crime or major disasters and incidents.

Crofton Police Officers may also assist AACoPD officers with any incident outside of the Crofton Special Community Benefit District within a reasonable distance.

1.2.4 MARYLAND STATE POLICE

The Maryland State Police exercises full law enforcement authority within the state of Maryland.
